

# Community VCAL courses 2005/6\*



These Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) based programs are the result of a collaborative approach by community, education and business to create alternative and engaging education programs for young people who are disengaged from mainstream schooling. The programs are flexible, varied and can cater to individual needs where appropriate.

Through community partnerships the Inner Eastern LLEN is facilitating five VCAL programs that engage more than 70 otherwise disengaged young people.

- ➔ **SKYS VCAL [Foundation]:** A flexible, multimedia-oriented course for those who have been out of education for some time. Includes a Cert. I in Media and Cert. I Workplace Education (can include Cert. II Broadcasting).
- ➔ **Hospitality VCAL [Intermediate]:** Building on the successes of a pilot Hospitality program last year, the IELLEN is delighted to offer a full VCAL in association with William Angliss this year.
- ➔ **Young Mums [Senior]:** this innovative program allows pregnant young women and new mothers the opportunity to build their parenting and literacy skills with unique support, access to Stonnington childcare through Prahran Neighbourhood House, a Community Services VET component, and the possibility of some flexible delivery.
- ➔ **VCAL at Swinburne TAFE, Hawthorn [Int. & Senior]:** these full VCAL programs offer VETs in Broadcasting, Horticulture, Hair & Beauty, Community Services, Hospitality, Media Studies, Furnishings. Plans are also underway for a TAFE Taster in Hospitality later in the year.
